REGULATION FOR STREET HAWKERS

- (a) whether Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) has made any rules/ regulations under Delhi Master Plan, 2021 to regulate the street hawkers in the corporation area;
- (b) whether it is a fact that large number of Residents Welfare Associations in the city are imposing monthly contribution on the street hawkers including those purchasing raddi and other similar hawkers visiting their respective areas; and
- (c) if so, the steps proposed to end this extortion?
