(a)&(b): The establishment of Street Vendors make significant contribution to the economy of the cities including pilgrim centres, by providing employment to the poor as well as supply of affordable goods and services to the residents and visitors. To protect livelihoods of the Street Vendors and to regulate their activities, the "Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, 2014 has been enacted by the Parliament.

The State Governments are in the process of making rules and scheme under this Act.
